Artists with a disability to light up Adelaide's night life

A dynamic new media artwork created by ten artists with a disability and their tutors from Tutti Arts will light up Adelaide's East End for the next five weeks as part of the Luminosity project produced by the Australian Network for Art & Technology (ANAT) in association with the City of Adelaide.

Tutti Arts' work *Lightspace* will be projected onto the eastern façade of the Centrepoint building in Rundle Street, along with three other artworks by South Australian media artists. *Lightspace* explores a theme of painting with light which the artists have used "to express happiness, power, mystery and fun".

Tutti Arts Film & New Media Coordinator Juha Vanhakartano says, "People living with learning disability often have limited opportunities to experience the nightlife. *Lightspace* will help to ensure artists with a disability are part of the cultural conversation and have a stronger presence in community spaces that are often closed to them."

About Luminosity

Large-scale, silent projections will screen onto the eastern façade of the Centrepoint building on Rundle Street, Adelaide until 23 February 2018.
