Local artist Scott Pyle realises a long-term goal with first solo exhibition

Cheltenham artist Scott Pyle realises a long-term goal this week with the opening of his first solo art exhibition titled *Just Me*.

The exhibition charts the course of Scott's artistic career and highlights his other passions - surfing and TV series such as Power Rangers and Home & Away. The exhibition also includes 20 portraits of Scott's friends and some famous faces.

Just Me opened on Sunday 28 October with the crowd of over 100 people delighting in the bright colours and bold brushstrokes prominent in Scott's art, and guest speaker Henry Jock Walker and Scott's surprise rendition of the Home and Away theme song. Many works were sold on opening night, including a series of exquisitely framed bespoke brooches.

Scott said, "I'm excited and honoured to have my first solo exhibition. It is also the second time in 5 years that I've sold a large painting."

Scott joined Tutti Arts' studios in 2009 and has created a large body of work since then. In 2017 he relocated to Tutti's new studio in Port Adelaide at Fontanelle Gallery & Studio two days per week.

Tutti Arts CEO Pat Rix says, "It has been fantastic to see Scott's career take off while he's been at Tutti. This is the reason we exist – to promote the development of artists with disability and have their work seen by as wide an audience as possible."

Just Me is open Thursday to Sunday from 1pm to 5pm until 25 November 2018 at Fontanelle Gallery & Studio, 175 St Vincent Street, Port Adelaide. Entry is free.
