Tutti Arts to expand its programs in the Barossa Valley

Tutti Arts has announced that its weekly Tanunda-based Visual Arts program for adult artists with a disability will expand to two days per week and will introduce a program for children aged 6 to 12 years. Led locally by Ali Devitt-Lansom, Tutti's Barossa Visual Arts group currently meet on Wednesdays at the CWA Hall in Tanunda. The adult program will be expanded to include Mondays and a one-hour visual arts program for kids will run afterwards from 4pm to 5pm.

Tutti's Barossa Visual Artists are currently showcasing their work in a vivacious and colourful exhibition entitled 'Brilliance' at Yalumba Wine Room as part of the 2019 SALA Festival. Invited personally by Annabel Hill-Smith of Yalumba, the group has created 62 new art works through workshops and exploration of new materials with the assistance of the Peter Lehmann Arts and Education Trust. 'Brilliance' is a full of surprises and features 'Tutti Moo', the larger than life sculpture and star of the 2019 Barossa Vintage Festival Parade, Brighton Jetty Sculptures and Angaston Town Day 2019.
