

Accessibility Information

What can I expect at the Heart Beat Club at MOD.?

Tickets:

- You'll need to buy a ticket via the website link before the Heart Beat Club starts.
- Tickets might be available at the door on the night unless they are sold out.
- If you have a Companion Card, you can bring someone along to support you without an extra ticket cost.

Parking and Transport:

- There is no car parking onsite, but there are on- and off-street car parks nearby.
- Nearby off-street car parks are Wilson Parking in Hindley Street or Care Park The Terrace on North Terrace
- Access Taxi: there is a useful car park slip lane outside the Jam Factory on Morphett Street to load/unload motorised wheelchairs.
- Tram: the closest tram stop is City West. It is opposite MOD.
- Train: it is about 400m to walk from the Adelaide Railway Station.

Wheelchair Access:

- Wheelchair access is via the front entrance. There is a ramp from North Terrace on the left of the automatic doors.
- The event is being held on the ground floor. The exhibition on the first floor can be accessed by a lift.

Music Volume:

- The music will be pretty loud to make the party more exciting.
- If you don't like loud music, you can bring your own ear protection.

Dance Floor Lights:

- The dance floor will have moving lights that change colour. But no flashing/strobing ones
- It's going to look cool with different kinds of lights.

Chill Out Zone:

- There are some quiet places inside the galleries if you need a break from the main event

Other Entertainment:

- If you're not into dancing, there are arcade games to play.
- You can have fun in different ways if dancing isn't your thing.

- There is an exhibition you can look at in the galleries. The galleries are on the ground floor and first floor.

Drinks:

- You can buy drinks at the bar, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic.
- If you want to buy alcoholic drinks, they might ask for your ID to show you are over 18 years old.
- You can't take your drinks outside.

Food:

- There will be food you can buy for dinner at the venue between 7pm – 9:30pm.
- The food menu is a Nachos Station to make your own nachos. It includes house-made corn chips, beef brisket chilli, hot nacho cheese sauce, pico de gallo, guacamole, sour cream, jalapenos and hot sauce.
- You can pre-order your nachos voucher when you buy your ticket.
- Or you can buy a nachos voucher at the venue until sold out.
- There will be limited numbers of nachos serves available. They may run out if you order late.
- There will be staff to help at the Nachos Station.

Seating:

- There will be some seats at the venue, but not very many.
- There is a big space for the dancefloor, so bring your dance shoes.

Accessible Bathroom:

- There's a wheelchair-accessible bathroom inside the venue.

Entry/Exit:

- You can come and go as you like during the event.
- If you need to leave and return, we might stamp your hand so you can get back in easily.
