# This is our visitor Access Guide for our Brighton Arts Centre.

Whether you are here to explore our projects and programs or as a partner or supporter we want you to feel comfortable.

Tutti Arts is a safe and welcoming place, where learning disabled and neurodivergent artists explore their creative talents and learn new skills.

We are delighted you are thinking about visiting us and hope this guide provides everything you need for a safe and comfortable trip.

Tutti Arts is located on the corner of Commercial Road and Strathmore Terrace, Brighton.

The paths around Tutti are sealed with bitumen or brick pavers.

Our main entrance is on Commercial Road.



The Visitor's Gate leads to the reception area.

All visitors must sign in at the reception desk before entering the premises.



### **Drop Off**

For safe drop off, there is a short term (1/4 P, 15 minute) parking bay on Commercial Road, this is 60 metres from the visitor's gate.





## Parking

There is all day parking at Brighton Train Station on Commercial Road and 2 hour parking on Strathmore Terrace.







There are also 6 accessible car parks on Old Beach Road.

#### Bus to Tutti

From the city, take the 262, 263 or 265 Bus to Stop 36 on Cedar Avenue. This stop is located 175 metres from Tutti.

#### Train to Tutti

You can take the Seaford train to Brighton Train Station, with a 120 metres walk to our entrance on Commercial Road.

## **Getting around Tutti**

If you have an appointment with Visual Arts, Marketing, our Disability Manager or are coming to see a Visual Arts exhibition, you may need to be on the first floor. Access is via a lift (Just left of the reception door).





#### Accessible bathrooms

There are two all gender access toilets at Tutti.

Downstairs, opposite our Performing Arts Centre, with a left hand rail.



Or upstairs, accessible via the lift, which has a right hand rail.

All bathrooms at Tutti have hand paper towels and dryers, sanitary products and wipes.

Tutti is a multi arts organisation where artists with disability build skills in Music, Dance, Visual Art, Screen, Digital Media and Theatre



### Accessible facilities

All gates and entrance doors have wheelchair access. There are two access toilets at Tutti, one downstairs and one upstairs (accessible via a lift).

### Assistance animals

Assistance animals are welcome. Some of our artists are afraid of dogs however, so please let us know in advance. That helps us ensure you and your assistance animal have a positive visit.



#### **No Smoking**

Tutti is a no smoking zone. If I need to smoke I will go onto the surrounding streets.



#### Good vibes only

We ask all our staff, artists and visitors to be kind, friendly, respectful of differences. We have a zero tolerance policy towards violence and abuse.



We also ask you to wear appropriate and safe clothing (closed shoes are especially important in our visual arts studio.)



## Our privacy policy

Tutti may collect visitor information to learn about your interests or access needs.



Tutti will keep visitor information private and secure. We will not share this unless in an emergency.



If you are attending an event at Tutti, we may be taking photographs or video. Please let us know if you do not want us to use your image. We will give you a sticker, so that we can ensure your privacy.
