Types of Legacy Gifts

You can structure your gift in several ways depending on your personal and family circumstances:

- **Residuary Gift (Recommended):** Leaves the remainder, or a percentage of the remainder, of your estate to Tutti Arts after your family, loved ones, and expenses are completely taken care of. This option adjusts with inflation over time.
- **Pecuniary Gift:** A specific, fixed sum of money nominated directly within your Will document.
- **Specific Asset Gift:** Leaving specific property, corporate shares, physical items, or actual completed artworks to the organisation.

A Step-by-Step Guide to Making Your Gift

1. **Loved Ones First:** Discuss your estate intentions with your family to ensure transparency.
2. **Consult a Legal Professional:** Take this information pack to a qualified solicitor or use an accredited Australian online Will writing platform.
3. **Insert the Correct Wording:** Copy and paste the recommended wording below into your new or updated Will document.
4. **Notify Tutti Arts (Optional):** You are under no legal obligation to tell us. However, sharing your intention allows us to thank you during your lifetime, ensure your wishes align with our future capabilities, and welcome you into our community.

Discuss the following templates with your solicitor and family to ensure your intentions are clear.

Option 1: For a Residuary Bequest (Preferred)

"I give to **Tutti Arts Incorporated (ABN 43 659 076 256)**, for its general purposes, **[IN WORDS - insert "the whole of" / or insert a specific percentage % of IN WORDS]** the residue of my estate, free of all duties and testamentary expenses. I direct that the receipt of the Executive Director or other proper officer of the organisation shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executors for this bequest."

Option 2: For a Pecuniary Bequest (Fixed Sum)

"I give to **Tutti Arts Incorporated (ABN 43 659 076 256)**, for its general purposes, the sum of **\$ [insert exact dollar amount]**, free of all duties and testamentary expenses. I direct that the receipt of the Executive Director or other proper officer of the organisation shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my executors for this bequest."
