Tandanya National Aboriginal Cultural Institute is located at 253 Grenfell Street, Adelaide SA 5000, on Kaurna Country. Tandanya is a safe and welcoming space for everyone to visit, learn and be inspired. Through Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander art, culture, stories and creative expression, we aim to educate visitors and celebrate the world's oldest continuing living cultures.

Arriving at Tandanya

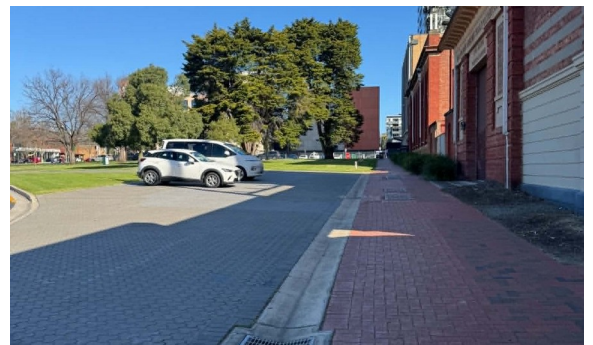
The main entrance is located on the corner of Grenfell Street and East Terrace. Entry through the front doors is wheelchair accessible.

Parking and drop-off

Tandanya does not have on-site or visitor parking. A safe drop-off point is available on the eastern side of the building for access vehicles.

Paid street parking may be available on Grenfell, Frome and Pirie streets and East Terrace. Check signs carefully, as limits and fees apply. Nearby off-street parking includes UPark Frome Street.

Travelling by bus

Stop R1 on the southern side of Grenfell Street, near 225–233 Grenfell Street, is a short distance from Tandanya. Routes include 117, 118, 141, 142, 144, 150, 155, 157 and several H20 services.

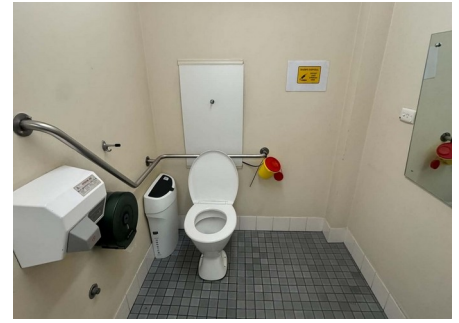
Clear access from the street, through the Main Hall and into our public spaces.

Getting around Tandanya

The ground floor, Main Hall and exhibition spaces are accessible through the front entrance. A lift in the Main Hall provides access to upstairs areas. Please ask a Tandanya staff member if you need help locating or using the lift.

Accessible toilets

An accessible toilet is available on the ground floor adjacent to the exhibition room.

Assistance animals

Assistance animals are warmly welcomed at Tandanya. Please let our team know if you or your assistance animal needs any additional support during your visit.

Public transport accessibility

Adelaide Metro buses and trains provide accessibility features, including boarding ramps. Check current access information and service updates before travelling.
